


Dear Parents/Carers,

Here is the information regarding keeping all the children safe in our school.

- **The Safeguarding of our pupils is of paramount importance.** We believe that Safeguarding children and young people is **EVERYONE's business**.
- If you or others have concerns about the safety or welfare of children or young people, it is your responsibility to act on those concerns. **The school phone numbers are 630 632 and 079 29 188 930.**
- The school's **Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL)** is [Mrs E Brophy](#) (Head teacher)
- [Mrs M Rowe](#) (Acting Deputy Head Teacher, Head of PS1 and 2 /ALNCO) and [Miss Rh. Whalley](#) (Reception class teacher) are the **Designated Safeguarding Officers** (DSO).
- The **Governor responsible** for Child Protection is [Mrs Tess Truss](#).
- If you have **any** concerns, no matter how minor you think they may be, please contact any of the named coordinators mentioned above, without delay.

- When a child makes an allegation against a family member or someone at the household, then, parental consent to make a referral to Ceredigion Social Services will NOT be sought by the school.
- The Social Services Department and the Police will need to speak to the child as soon as possible if there are serious concerns or it is believed a crime has been committed.
