We are aiming to charge £7 per night and this will include a snack. The children will wait in the classes / or wait on the playground then they will be collected by the afterschool assistants and the club will run until 5pm on a Monday, Wednesday and Thursday evening. This is a trial period (until the end of the Summer Term 2025) of the school administering and running the afterschool club. If it is successful, we will add more nights. Please use the club or risk losing it. We don't aim to make a profit, and just wish to make enough to cover the wages, the food, the heating and any resources. An electronic form will be sent out this week so you can register for the days that you would like your child to attend.

Health and Safety Procedures:

On Thursday 23rd January, we will carry out another full lockdown practice in the afternoon. **We aim to keep everything very low-key again and would be grateful if you took the same approach.** Our aim is to ensure that these safety practices, though necessary, do not cause any concern to the children. We wish to carry out the lockdown when I am in my teaching role.
